In May 2022, Deus Culpa began performing live, sharing their energy with audiences across Greece and southern Europe. They joined Lone Survivors as the opening act for the Burning Mask Tour while also collaborating with various local bands for shows within their home country.

In 2023, Deus Culpa continued to make waves on stage. Notably, they opened for Matt Barlow and Freddie Vidales' Ashes of Ares in Heraklion, Crete, as part of the Over the Wall Festival.







Later that year, in September, the band took the stage at the Soundart Festival in Malta, performing alongside Krishna, A Black White Satellite, and Grande Fox.





April 2024 marked a significant milestone for Deus Culpa. Representing Greece at the Metal Days Festival, their electrifying performance earned them an impressive second place, cementing their reputation as a band to watch.



In July 2024, Deus Culpa was invited to join the lineup of the prestigious Metalhead Meeting in Bucharest, Romania. Sharing the stage with metal icons such as **Judas Priest**, **Doro**, **Steel Panther**, and **Rotting Christ**, the band held their own among legends of the genre.

The momentum carried into October 2024, as Deus Culpa returned to Romania to perform at the Rock n' lasi Festival, further solidifying their presence in the international metal scene.





In recent months, Deus Culpa has begun unveiling new material from their highly anticipated debut album. The band has already released two singles, "So Many Years" and "Bliss You," each accompanied by striking music videos that showcase their unique sound and artistic vision. With more tracks and visuals set to drop in the lead-up to the album's full release, Deus Culpa is building excitement and momentum among fans and the music community alike.
